Nautilus Chip & Dip



Pottery & Materials

GA-3075 Nautilus Chip and Dip Platter

NTG-9537 Mermaid Scales 4 oz.

NTG-9540 Denim Daze 4 oz.

NTG-9538 Plum Island 4 oz.

Aqualon Soft Fan Brush #8

Sponge, Water, Paper Towel,

Instructions

- Moisten a sponge and wipe bisque to remove any dust or contaminants.
- Flip your pottery over and start with painting the back side of the platter. Using the soft fan brush, paint 1 coat of Plum Island over the center trail. Paint 1 coat of Denim Daze around all the sides (overlapping the Plum Island slightly) and then paint 1 coat of Mermaid Scales on the edges (overlapping the Denim Daze slightly) where the back of the piece touches the table you are working on. Repeat this step 2 more times until you have achieved 3 coats of glaze everywhere on the back side of the platter and let dry (glaze will achieve a matte look).
- Flip the platter over and repeat this same technique on the front of the platter. Start with 1 coat of Mermaid Scales on the outer and top edges all the way down to the center swirl. Then paint an overlapping coat of Denim Daze to the inner sides, then paint the remaining center trail with Plum Island (overlapping Denim Daze). As you paint your brush will catch on the ribbing of the design and have a slightly raised look of the Plum Island (as long as that's the top (last) glaze used. Repeat this process 2 more times until you have achieved 3 full coats of glaze over the entire front of the piece and let dry.
- This piece MUST have 3 total coats of glaze painted on the entire surface as we do not apply a clear glaze over these particular glazes so be sure to keep track of your coat counts as you go.
- Return your piece to us for firing!
